1 MR. AMODIO: Call the meeting to order. 2 On the roll. 3 (Roll call was taken, all Commissioners 4 5 present respond in the affirmative. Commissioner 6 Vannoy is not in the room. Commissioner Levine 7 are not present yet. President Sanchez is absent) 8 9 MR. AMODIO: The time is 9:38 a.m. 10 You have a quorum. 11 All of the requirements of the Open Public 12 Meetings Act have been met. 1 2 PRESIDENT PRO TEM LEVINE: Abstain. MR. AMODIO: We have the agreement with 3 Mr. Lisbona. Counsel, if you'd like to recite that. 5 MR. HANLEY: Yes. 6 7 Mr. Lisbona, of the firm of Dwyer, Connell Lisbona, submitted a proposal regarding Passaic 8 9 Valley Water Commissioners against claims which he believes we should assert against ITT Water and 10 11 Wastewater Leopold, McManimon, Scotland, Baumann, 12 and Prismatic, although as I understood his explanation, the lawsuit will be only filed 13 14 against McManimon, Scotland, Baumann. 15 You have a proposal that you reviewed 16 carefully, I understand, dated December 9th which 17 I'll summarize it briefly. 18 It concludes the fact that legal fees will 19 be contingent on prevailing in the lawsuit and the 20 Commission would be responsible for disbursements 21 and other out of pocket expenses, experts, et 22 cetera, court reporters, and so on.

And after reviewing this matter in closed session, I believe it's the consensus of the Commission that they would like him to proceed

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with that lawsuit and retain them for that 1 2 purpose. His proposal sets forth details which would be reduced to a written agreement in the 3 form that we normally utilize. 5 So at this point, I quess you'll be 6 seeking a vote on that proposal and to award that 7 contract. MR. AMODIO: Do I have a motion? 8 9 COMMISSIONER KOLODZIEJ: So moved. COMMISSIONER CLEAVES: Second. 10 11 MR. AMODIO: By Commissioner Kolodziej. 12 Second by Commissioner Cleaves. 13 14 (Roll call was taken, all Commissioners 15 present respond in the affirmative. Commissioner 16 Bazian and President Sanchez are absent) 17 18 MR. HANLEY: I'm sorry, I did want to 19 repeat, for the record, some material terms. 20 It's a Contingency Agreement which would 21 be 25 percent of any amount recovered prior to 22 mediation and arbitration or litigation and one 23 third of any amount recovered afterwards. 24 And the hourly rate, which would measure 2.5 the work and the value of the work but not would

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1	be an hourly rate you're paying because you won't
2	be paying one, but the hourly rate would be
3	measured by the \$275 per hour.
4	COMMISSIONER DeVITA: Which we are not
5	paying.
6	MR. HANLEY: Which you are not paying.
7	MR. AMODIO: Okay.
8	MR. HANLEY: Simply a measurement for
9	purposes of keeping track of how much work is
10	actually expended.
11	PRESIDENT PRO TEM LEVINE: Let me ask you
12	a question, George. Say we win this lawsuit and
13	he gets paid lawyers fees back, does he get one
14	third of our thing plus the lawyers fees?
15	MR. HANLEY: Yes. And he will be seeking
16	recovery on your behalf.
17	PRESIDENT PRO TEM LEVINE: Would we get
18	back the lawyers fees?
19	MR. HANLEY: To the extent that you would
20	have to pay any lawyer fees, which you would not
21	be expected to under this agreement, you are
22	entitled to reimburse him for those fees of
23	McManimon & Scotland and anybody else who we had
24	to pay under this project.
25	PRESIDENT PRO TEM LEVINE: All right.

1	MR. AMODIO: Moving along.
2	Controller.
3	MR. WEISS: You have three Resolutions in
4	front of you.
5	We've got a Budget Resolution, as we've
6	been discussing. This is to approve the Budget
7	for 2014. Then we'll adopt the Budget in January.
8	We've got the Budget Submission
9	Resolution.
10	We've got the Rate Resolution.
11	We've discussed this extensively. If
12	anybody has any further questions, I'll be happy
13	to answer them, otherwise, I would ask for
14	COMMISSIONER DeVITA: So you're not going
15	to answer them?
16	MR. WEISS: I'll be happy to answer them.
17	COMMISSIONER KOLODZIEJ: Believe me, he
18	answered them all in committee.
19	MR. HANLEY: The Rate Resolution before
20	you, by the way, is based on the Cost of Service
21	Study you also have in your hand and have reviewed
22	and discussed.
23	COMMISSIONER DeVITA: Can I ask a
24	question? I just have a question.
25	With our rates, are there going to be in

1	addition to percentage increases any other
2	increases?
3	MR. WEISS: I didn't follow, I'm sorry.
4	COMMISSIONER DeVITA: In other words,
5	previously, we adopted rate increase that says X
6	percent, but there were also other increases and
7	fees to customers.
8	MR. WEISS: Yes. That's actually included
9	in the Rate Resolution. There's a schedule.
10	COMMISSIONER DeVITA: So we're not going
11	to have someone saying there's \$20 on my bill?
12	It's all inclusive?
13	MR. WEISS: That's all inclusive. In
14	other words, the rates are spelled out for all
15	different categories
16	COMMISSIONER DeVITA: And included?
17	MR. AMODIO: Correct. We will publish
18	that. It will be advertised in the newspapers and
19	probably, I guess, the newspaper of North
20	Arlington if there's a different one.
21	MR. HANLEY: I would think, you know, you
22	have to send them by contract wholesale.
23	MR. AMODIO: Yes.
24	MR. HANLEY: Which I know you already
25	sent, wasn't adopted. And in addition to that, I

1	would think you would have to send one to each
2	municipality that we service.
3	MR. AMODIO: Yes, we certainly do.
4	Any other questions?
5	Would you like to do all three in one
6	vote?
7	COMMISSIONER KOLODZIEJ: Yes.
8	MR. AMODIO: Is there a motion?
9	COMMISSIONER VANNOY: Move it.
10	MR. HANLEY: I think the Budget
11	MR. WEISS: I think the Budget has to be
12	separate.
13	MR. HANLEY: You have to do the Rate
14	first.
15	MR. AMODIO: Rate Resolution first, by
16	Commissioner Kolodziej.
17	Do I have a second?
18	COMMISSIONER CLEAVES: Second.
19	MR. AMODIO: By Commissioner Cleaves.
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21	(Roll call was taken, all Commissioners
22	present respond in the affirmative. Commissioner
23	Bazian and President Sanchez are absent)
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25	MR. AMODIO: Motion approved.

1 Would you like to give your report? 2 MR. WEISS: Cash on hand is 17.2 million. Our accounts receivable is 12.1 million. 3 Thirty days or less accounts receivable are 11.5 million, which is just above 95 percent. 6 Accounts payable is at 2.7 million. Commissioner Bazian mentioned about the 7 8 interest that we've been getting back on some of 9 our investments. You have a copy of the most 10 recent bank balances. You might want to take a 11 look at that. It is working out wonderfully well 12 for us. We want to continue for next year in 13 terms of investing our funds the way we've been. 14 I just want to report the bank charges 15 because we did the banking RFP. Our bank charges 16 for November were down to \$2,800 from 16,000. So 17 that's also something working very much in our favor. 18 19 That's all I have, unless somebody has 20 questions. 21 MR.
