PASSAIC VALLEY WATER COMMISSION INDEMNIFICATION AND HOLD HARMLESS AGREEMENT

This Indemnification and Hold Harmless Agreement (the "Agreement") between Passaic Valley Water Commission, "Indemnifier" (hereinafter "PVWC") having offices at 1525 Main Avenue, Clifton, New Jersey 07011, (the "Premises") and Roman E & G Corporation, having offices at 14 Ogden Street, New Jersey 07104 the "Indemnitee" (hereinafter "Roman").

WHEREAS, Roman will support PVWC's Distribution Department to conduct all hydrant and valve inspections in advanced of the hydrant replacement work for up to 1,000 job sites, assigned by PVWC throughout the Commission's territories; and

WHEREAS, it is desirous to allow Roman to utilize equipment and tools to access and operate PVWC's valves and hydrants for performing said inspections; and

WHEREAS, PVWC is amenable to permit Roman to utilize equipment and tools to aid Roman in conducting the inspection of valves and hydrants, limited as to the time required to perform all Work under Contract No. 22-B-16.

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the recitals, the mutual promises and covenants herein and other good and valuable consideration, the receipt and sufficiency of which is hereby acknowledged, the parties hereto agree as follows:

PVWC, on behalf of its officers, agents, employees, contractors and affiliated agencies, hereby acknowledges, recognizes and agrees that Roman shall not be responsible, unless in the case of negligence, for any damage caused to PVWC's assets, including valves, hydrants and water mains occurring in connection with or arising out of the proposed activities to be conducted in or about or in connection with the job sites or otherwise, by reason of any existing or future condition, defect, matter or thing in said premises, or for the acts or omissions of any persons or entities including any equipment, fixture apparatus or facilities in connection with or related to said activities. PVWC agrees to hold Roman harmless, indemnify, defend and save Roman from any and all claims and liability for losses of or damage to property or injuries to or death of any persons or entities in connection with proposed activities or in connection with, or arising out of said activities, including, but not limited to the obligation to defend Roman together with any other costs, fees, or expenses which arise out of the activities and circumstances contemplated by, or arising out of, or caused by this Agreement or any actions, omissions or activities arising therefrom.
